

RAJAGIRI MARATHON, 2024

Date: - Sunday, Dec 15th 2024,

Venue: - Rajagiri Public School, Kalamassery

Welcome to the 5th edition of the Rajagiri Marathon! Your participation in the RAJAGIRI MARATHON implies your agreement to adhere to the entry conditions outlined below, along with any instructions provided by the race organizers and officials. Your commitment to these guidelines ensures a smooth and enjoyable marathon experience for all participants. Best of luck on your marathon journey!

Please collect your bib from Rajagiri Public School, Kalamassery on December 14th, between 8 am and 7 pm.

Important Instructions for the Day:

- It is required to have the bib for run tracking. While all registered participants are permitted to run, the absence of a time chip will result in the non-issuance of medals or certificates.
- The use of roller skates, wheelbarrows, bicycles, or any other devices that enhance motion is strictly prohibited on the course.
- Any form of assistance to complete the course is strictly prohibited. Disqualification will be enforced for individuals caught using any kind of vehicle for transportation.
- Pets or Animals are not allowed.
- Locker facilities will not be available. Runners are responsible for safeguarding their valuables at their own risk.
- Parking space for runners is limited, and we encourage carpooling or utilizing hired car services. If you choose to bring your own vehicle, please park at your own risk.
- Entry to the campus strictly restricted through back gate as we will be using front gate for race route. So requested to take T.O.G Road-> Karippai Road to enter through back gate.
- Use of illicit substances / drugs is strictly prohibited.
- The race will conclude, and the finish line will close promptly at 08:00 am. Strict enforcement will be in place, with race officials initiating the packing and wrapping up of the event at this time. Beyond this point, no runners will be permitted to continue as per regulations preventing road closures. Administrative authorities mandate the timely conclusion, and any participants on the course after the cut-off time will be directed to enter the sweep vehicle.
- All runners must complete the Marathon Run within specified time limits. Participants still on the course after the overall cut-off time will be directed to the sweep vehicle.

Cut-off Times:

21.1K Half Marathon - 3 hours and 30 minutes (4.30am – 8:00am)

10K (student & open category) - 2 hours (6:00am – 8:00am)

3K (Fun Run category) - 1 hour (6:30am – 7:30am)

- The ultimate decision on whether a runner must exit the race rests with race officials and medical personnel, and runners are urged to comply. Strict adherence to the cut-off time will be maintained, prioritizing the safety of the runners and compliance with regulations.
- **Race Medal** - Participants who successfully complete the course distance for their respective events will receive race medals. It's important to note that non-participants are NOT eligible for race medals. Winners will be determined based on chip reading, and the organizer's decision in this regard will be final.

- **Certificates** - E- Certificates can be downloaded for all the runners.
- **Race Chest Card Numbers** - For safety reasons and for identification by medical staff, the swapping, sale, resale or transfer of race Chest Card Numbers is strictly prohibited. Participants must exclusively use the Chest Card Number allotted to them.
- Cash awards and medals will be awarded to both men and women participating in the Half Marathon, as well as the 10K run, based on the specified age categories.

- The 21.1K, 10K and 3K race categories will follow the same route but with different turning points.
- 8 Hydration Stations will be positioned at one-kilometre intervals along the route.
- Hydration stations will be stocked with electrolytes, water, oranges, bananas, peanut candy and salt.
- Every hydration station will function as a Medical Station.
- Bio-toilets will be positioned in proximity to Hydration Station No: 4.
- Ambulance services will be accessible, and for any form of assistance, please reach out to the race volunteers.
- A physiotherapy facility is provided at the finishing point for stretching, therapy and other related services.
- Registered runners will receive breakfast at the finishing point.
- Clearly marked turning points will be designated for each category, with Race Volunteers assisting in their identification.
- Runners must wear their chest cards throughout the event, displaying them on the front of their T-shirts until the conclusion of the event. Any violation will result in disqualification.
- Rejection - The organizer retains the authority to deny participation to any runner. Any participant discovered jeopardizing their safety or that of others will be promptly removed from the course and event venue.

The organizers retain the right to remove, ban, or exclude any participant found in breach of the aforementioned terms and conditions. The decision of the organizers will be conclusive in such instances.
